Sonia DiFranco - Spanish Teacher

"My name is Sonia Di Franco. I was born in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, where I obtained a BA in Foreign Language Education from Universidad Nacional Pedro Henriquez Ureña. After teaching English as a Second Language and Kindergarten for six years at The Carol Morgan School of Santo Domingo, I moved to Miami, Florida in 1989 to continue my teaching career at Gulliver Academy, an Independent Day School in Coral Gables, FL, where I taught Spanish at the elementary level for seventeen years. In 2006 I relocated to Raleigh, NC to start my job as the Language Studies Coordinator at Casa Esperanza Montessori Charter School. During my time there, I developed and supervised
